The president or any two members may call a special meeting of the Board of Education, by serving on the other members a written notice of the time and place of the meeting. Notice to each member shall be sent by mail at least 24 hours before the meeting. No business shall be transacted except that for which the meeting is called and which shall be stated in the call.
