- I. LIMITATIONS ON DISCUSSIONS The President may stop any discussion, which does not apply to the motion last made. He may also stop the discussion of a matter if the Board has previously agreed to confine discussion to a definite period of time.
- II. MOTIONS

A motion is out of order while another motion is being discussed, unless it is an amendment to the motion under consideration. Exceptions are the motion to adjourn, motion to table previous motion, motion to refer to the motion being discussed, and the motion to vote immediately (on the previous question) are always in order.
