**Policy Title: Virtual School Students** 

The School District of Webster will work with families to provide virtual schooling options for our students. A virtual student will be defined as a student who takes one or more courses approved by the School District of Webster.

Students who take virtual classes will be subject to all of the general policies of the Webster School District, including the following:

- 1. Students enrolled in virtual classes will be considered students of the School District of Webster and will be subject to all state laws and Board policies.
- 2. All virtual courses will be approved by the School District of Webster.
- 3. The School District of Webster will assign qualified advisors who will provide guidance and support.
- 4. Students enrolled in virtual classes must be residents of the Webster School District in order to participate in WIAA activities as well as co-curricular activities as listed in the co-curricular code.
- 5. Students enrolled in virtual classes shall be allowed to participate in school-sponsored field trips that are appropriate for their age and subject areas.
- 6. Students enrolled in virtual classes who fulfill all requirements for graduation will be eligible for a diploma from the School District of Webster.
