Policy Title: Graduation Policy for Foreign Exchange Students

Diplomas will be awarded to foreign exchange students at the discretion of the Webster School Board. Only those exchange students who are completing their fourth year of secondary schooling and have provided official documentation or transcripts of their course of study will be considered. In addition, those eligible students must meet the current Wisconsin minimum state requirements for graduation. Beginning with the 2003-2004 school year, all foreign exchange students must meet the Webster School Board's criteria for graduation as adopted on 10/16/2000 (excepting the total credit requirement) along with meeting the minimum Wisconsin State requirements for graduation.
