**Policy Title: Student Assessment Programs** 

The Webster School District will honor parents' request to excuse a student from participating in State testing in grades 4, 8, 9, 10 and 11 per Wis. Statutes 118.30 (1r) 2.3.

This request must be made by September 30<sup>th</sup> of the testing year. The decision of whether or not to honor a parent's request to excuse a student from state testing at grades 3, 5, 6 and 7 will rest with the school district.
