Policy Title: Student Assessment Programs

The Webster School District will honor parents' request to excuse a student from participating in State testing in grades 4, 8, 9, 10 and 11 per Wis. Statutes 118.30 (1r) 2.3.

This request must be made by September 30th of the testing year. The decision of whether or not to honor a parent's request to excuse a student from state testing at grades 3, 5, 6 and 7 will rest with the school district.
