Policy Title: **Student Conduct on School Buses**

### **POLICY FOR BUS RULES INFRACTION**

*The following process shall be followed with regard to infractions of school bus rules.*

**1<sup>st</sup> Offense**-Transportation Director and/or Building Principal will meet with the student and provide said student with a verbal and written warning that the indicated behavior is not allowed. Copy of written warning will also be sent to parents/guardians.

**2<sup>nd</sup> Offense**-Transportation Director and/or Building Principal will meet the same as in 1<sup>st</sup> offense. The student will be suspended from riding privileges for five (5) days. A letter will be sent to the parents/guardians notifying them of the continuing problems and consequences of any future problems.

**3<sup>rd</sup> Offense**-The student and parent/guardian will meet with the Transportation Director and Principal. The parents/guardians will receive a copy of the misconduct report and a letter indicating that the student is suspended from riding for ten (10) days.

**4<sup>th</sup> Offense**-The student and parent appear before the Transportation committee for the consideration of suspension of riding privileges for ninety (90) school days. The Administration shall provide a written copy of the misconduct report and a letter to the parents/guardians indicating the date, time and location of the transportation committee meeting.

The school transportation committee may, upon consideration of circumstances, elevate the misconduct referral to a more advanced level or response than the above calls for if said committee determines this action to be in the best interest of the safe transportation of students.

***The school transportation committee shall consist of the Superintendent, Transportation Director, Building Principals, and a school board member.***
