Policy Title: Locker Searches

Any hall, classroom or locker room locker assigned to a student is the property of the School District of Webster. At no time does the District relinquish its exclusive control of such lockers. A locker may be searched as determined necessary or appropriate, without notice, without student consent, and without a search warrant. The district administrator, a building principal, assistant principal or any employee specifically designated by the district administrator or building principal may conduct the search. A police-school liaison officer, a law enforcement officer, or any other agency official at the request of or in conjunction with school authorities may also conduct the search.

Any unauthorized item found in the locker may be removed. Items removed from the locker may be held by the school for return to the parent(s)/guardian of the student or parent/guardian of a minor student shall be notified of items removed from the locker and turned over to law enforcement officials.

The district shall include a copy of this policy in the student handbook that is distributed annually to each student enrolled in the District beginning with the 1999-2000 school year. All students will be given a paper of this policy in January of 1999.
